Regulations: Bill No. 22 Workers Safety and Compensation Act

Under Bill No. 22 Workers Safety and Compensation Act Sec. 27 Duties of employers 2.d) "make reasonable efforts to check the well-being of a worker in situations when the worker is employed under conditions that present a significant hazard of injury or death, or when the worker might not be able to secure assistance in the event of injury or other misfortune; and comply with this Part and the regulations."
